Sign in before play (HDiD)



1. Open the HDiD app or log-in at www.howdidido.com/Account/Login
2. Tap **Today's Golf**:




3. Tap **Sign In/Pre-registration**:



4. Choose the appropriate competition (there may be more than one) and tap **Sign In**:


Now go play your round . . .

Entering your scores (HDiD)

You may enter your scores:

- after the round at the PSI screen, or
- during/after the round through HowDidiDo as follows:


1. Tap **Today's Golf**:



2. Tap **Score Entry**:



3. Choose the appropriate competition (there may be more than one) and tap **Enter Scores**:



4. Enter the name of your marker and then tap **Next**:

5. Enter your gross score for the first hole. You can use the “+” or “-” buttons until the correct score is displayed, then tap **Hole 2**:

You: Graeme Bunting (HI: 12.1, CH: 10, PH: 10)

If you enter “0” or tap the “No Score” button you will be asked if you:

- “Did Not Play” the hole, or
- “Played But Did Not Score”



For handicap purposes it is important to differentiate between “Did Not Play” and “Played But Did Not Score”.

*Holes not played for a legitimate reason are allocated an “Expected Score” based on the handicap of the player, whereas holes played but not completed are recorded as **Net Double Bogey**.*

Circumstances where “Did Not Play” may be justifiably used include:

- a) Competitions scheduled over less than 18 holes*
- b) A hole closed for maintenance*
- c) A player having to discontinue play due to becoming ill, or injured or being called off the course for an emergency.*
- d) Fading Daylight*
- e) The competition being suspended by the Committee due to dangerous or extreme weather conditions.*

A player may not enter “Did Not Play” if they decide to walk in because they are playing badly or the weather is unpleasant.

5. Continue entering your scores for each hole. After the 9th hole tap **Next** to confirm your front 9 score (or **Back** to investigate any discrepancies):



6. After the 18th hole, tap **Finish**:



7. Tap **Next** to confirm your back 9 score (or **Back** to investigate any discrepancies):




8. Check that your 18 hole score is correct and add your signature.

Note: It is important to investigate any discrepancies and correct as required:

Then tap **Confirm**,

... followed by **Finish**:



Finally, post your signed scorecard in the letter-box near the PSI screen (or any other place designated for a specific competition).
