

Terms and Conditions of Flexible Membership at Mapperley Golf Club

These Terms & Conditions apply to the *Flexible Membership* category at Mapperley Golf Club (MGC) and are to be read in conjunction with the **General Terms and Conditions of Membership at MGC**.

1.How Flexible Membership Works

Flexible Membership is a points based scheme whereby you purchase a number of points each year and you can use those points to purchase rounds of golf, either 18 holes or 9 holes.

The number of points required to purchase a round varies depending on the time of year and day of the week, as shown on the Flexible Membership page on the MGC website.

2.Membership Year

- The Membership Year runs from 1st April to 31st March and your initial purchase for a full year is £550. After a small deduction to pay for England Golf and County affiliation fees, you will be credited 529 points.
- If you have already paid affiliation fees at another golf club you will be credited with 550 points.
- If you join part way through a Membership Year your initial payment will be pro-rata'd on a monthly basis.
- You may top up your points at any time during the year by logging into your BRS account and paying online.
- Any unused points at the end of the Membership Year will transfer over to the next year as long as you renew your subscription by 31st March. If you do not renew your membership by 31st March any unused points will be forfeited and are not transferable to any other member.
- The number and value of points will be reviewed by the MGC Board from time to time and they may make changes to the subscriptions and Terms and Conditions as appropriate. Members will be informed when any changes are made.

3.Booking Golf

As a Flexible Member at MGC, you may:

- Book tee times for casual golf up to 7 days in advance through the Professional Shop or by logging into your BRS account.
- Use your points for up to 3 guests playing in the same tee time as you.
- Play in stroke play competitions, including Major competitions, subject to the provisions of item [b] in the <u>Terms of Competition, Appendix A</u>.
- Play in team matches against other clubs, subject to the provisions of items
 [d] and [e] in the <u>Terms of Competition, Appendix A</u>.

Note:

- It is your responsibility to make sure that every time you play your name is added to the BRS timesheet and that the appropriate number points are deducted from your account.
- 9 hole bookings are for playing a maximum of 9 holes only. If you intend to play more than 9 holes you must make an 18 hole booking prior to play.
- Failure to comply with the above may result in your membership being terminated with no refund of fees paid.
